## **TILE TYPE**

Glazed - ceramic	~	Care must be taken not to get the DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER in the grout joints. Use a cloth and apply just to the surface.
Unglazed - ceramic	~	Care must be taken not to get the DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER in the grout joints. Use a cloth and apply just to the surface.
Porcelain	~	Care must be taken not to get the DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER in the grout joints. Use a cloth and apply just to the surface.
Natural Stone – translucent / water sensitive (water sensitive may suggest resin agglomerated stone)	~	Care must be taken not to get the DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER in the grout joints. Use a cloth and apply just to the surface.
Natural Stone – non translucent	~	Care must be taken not to get the DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER in the grout joints. Use a cloth and apply just to the surface.
Mosaics - ceramic	~	Care must be taken not to get the DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER in the grout joints. Use a cloth and apply just to the surface.
Mosaics - porcelain	~	Care must be taken not to get the DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER in the grout joints. Use a cloth and apply just to the surface.
Mosaics – natural stone	~	Care must be taken not to get the DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER in the grout joints. Use a cloth and apply just to the surface.

#### **IN A NUTSHELL**

DUNLOP TEMPORARY TILE SEALER is a protective sealer for use on most tile types to protect the surface of the tile from discolouration during grouting. The sealer is removed by simply washing off after grout application.

#### APPLICATION

Ensure surface is clean and free from dust, apply undiluted sealer with a clean cloth before grouting avoiding the joints. Allow to dry for 15 minutes minimum before applying a second coat (more coats may be required depending on the material porosity) Allow to dry fully before commencing grouting. Note it must be applied and left to dry just before the grouting process.

#### COVERAGE

500g undiluted covers approx. 5m2, on very porous tiles this may be less.
