SITUATION

Walls	V	The surface must be clean, dry, sound and flat. Used on plaster backgrounds when using a DUNLOP Cement based adhesives or where the background surface is porous.
Floors	V	The surface must be clean, dry, sound and flat. Brush down highly polished surfaces before priming. NOTE ensure a even coat is applied, do NOT allow to form puddles on the surface. Ensure a Damp proof membrane is incorporated below direct to earth sub floors

IN A NUTSHELL

DUNLOP MULTI-PURPOSE PRIMER is a ready to use acrylic primer for sealing and priming substrates including porous backgrounds prior to tiling or applying DUNLOP LEVELLING COMPOUNDS. It is suitable for wall and floor surfaces prior to the application of ceramic, mosaic or natural stone tiles in most interior and exterior including wet areas.

APPLICATION

Shake bottle before use. Apply 2 undiluted coats with a paintbrush on plaster, plasterboard, floorboards or screeds, or diluted with water 1:1 on plaster if using a ready mixed wall tile adhesive or on cement floors. Allow to dry for approx. 30 minutes between coats. For levelling on cement:sand screeds or concrete use diluted at 1:1 with clean cold water, apply with a brush or roller and allow to dry.

For levelling on Anhydrite/ Calcium sulphate screeds, apply 2 coats, first diluted at 1:1 ratio with water by volume, and allow to dry. Then apply the second coat undiluted at 90° to the first coat and allow to dry.

COVERAGE

1kg undiluted covers approx. 10m2, on very porous backgrounds this may be less.
