HOW TO WATERPROOF A SHOWER OR WET AREA:



► Watch Now

PRIME



Apply the primer to clean dry wall areas (to the required height), and floor areas, using a paint brush, and leave until touch dry.

TAPE CORNERS & JOINTS



Apply a layer of DUNLOP WATERPROOF COATING with a paint brush to any area where there are joints including: corners of walls, along the tray or floor junctions, columns, pipe penetrations and outlets and any other cracks or joints in the background.

Cut the tape to the joint length and push into the wet layer of coating ensuring no voids are left beneath the tape. Form a continuous strip around the shower tray, slightly overlapping the top of the tray.

Apply a second layer of coating over the tape and remaining wall areas using a brush, roller or trowel and leave to dry for 24 hours.

FINISH



Once the coating is dry, you can begin the tiling using a suitable adhesive such as DUNLOP CF-03 FLEXIBLE FAST SETTILE ADHESIVE.

Do I really need a tanking solution?

If you're interested in following the British Standard Institute (BSI) guidelines you should. Under the latest revision in clause 6.1.1.3, it states that wet areas should be protected with a suitable propriety tanking membrane system. Furthermore, the costs incurred from some types of water leaks may not be covered by the home insurance policy.

A wet area is any wetroom, bathroom, shower area, steam room or any other area subject to frequent water contact. This includes walls and floors in a wetroom, walls within a shower cubicle and walls around a bath or shower.
