
How does it work?

The NEW Dunlop ProCover Uncoupling Mat gives you the confidence to tile onto difficult floors which are at risk from stresses and lateral movement.

What it means for you

- Ideal for tiling onto timber floors and new sand & cement screeds
- ✓ Perfect for underfloor or undertile heating
- ✓ Prevents cracking or de-bonding of the tiles

- Pre-marked gridlines to help cutting

Instructions for use

- Always prepare the background to the requirements of the substrate.
- Ensure the floor is sound, flat and free from loose particles and dust. Roll the mat out on the floor area and cut to the required size using scissors or a utility knife. The printed gridlines will help ensure accurate sizing.
- Move the mat to one side and spread a layer of suitable Dunlop tile adhesive, such as Dunlop Set Fast Plus Floor & Wall Tile Adhesive, onto the floor using a 4mm notched trowel.
- Smooth the mat into the wet adhesive, ensure any edges are butted up but do not overlap the edges of the mat. It is important to apply the mat within the working time of the adhesive. Any break or join in the background must be married with a break in the mat.
- The mat must be fully pressed into the tile adhesive, this can be achieved using a trowel or float over the surface to gently push out any air pockets. Remove any tile adhesive which has extruded through the joints.
- Once the mat is in place, you can immediately begin tiling using a suitable tile adhesive such as Dunlop Set Fast Plus Floor & Wall Tile Adhesive or Dunlop Large Format & Natural Stone Floor Tile Adhesive. Spread the adhesive over the mat using a suitable thick bed solid bed trowel and lay the tiles as normal. The total thickness of adhesive on top of the mat must not exceed 6mm.
